Problem: Homeland Security Presidential Directive #8 (HSPD-8) called for a National Preparedness Goal to establish measurable priorities, targets, and a common approach to developing needed capabilities for all-hazards planning.

Solution: Bridgeborn developed a web-based application designed to develop, maintain, and deliver the Target Capabilities List (TCL) and Universal Task List (UTL) to meet the need established by HSPD-8. The solution creates a single, authoritative source for all TCL and UTL content, which is available for the general public and authorized DHS software tools via web services. The application provides features for version control and change management of content.

Value to Client: Prior to Bridgeborn's support of DHS, the TCL/UTL existed as stand alone documents with no version control. Bridgeborn's solution allows DHS to quickly and easily update and control content as well as simplify the distribution of updates (via the web) to the TCL and UTL as they are adjudicated and published. The use of web services in the solution ensures consistent information exchange and interoperability among various DHS systems. Additional value is recognized by the end user community through the implementation of an intuitive, web accessible user interface. The ease of use and accessibility has increased usage and user acceptance.
